When on-line submitting, please choose the submission category "WG Workshop".

Additionally, a WG Chair can apply requesting to the SPC a time slot (up to 60 minutes) for a WG business meeting. No formal submission is required.

Go to the instructions for authors and to the online submission for detailed information. Final acceptance and publishing of a contribution to MIE2012 is conditioned on the following:

- submitted by March 1st, 2012
- revision of the contribution according to SPC's suggestions
- formatted strictly adhering to the requirements specified in the provided IOS Press template
- the presenting author(s) are registered to the conference and delegate fees are paid, no later than May 7, 2012 (early bird deadline).
